Item 19 – Privacy Notice

FACTS	WHAT DOES PRIVATE CAPITAL MANAGEMENT DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number, income, and net worth Account numbers, balances, transactions, and holdings Risk tolerance and investment experience When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice and will retain that information for at least as long applicable regulations so require.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Private Capital Management chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include financial companies such as banks.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Private Capital Management does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Private Capital Management does not jointly market.

Other Important Information

If you live in a state where the laws further restrict the sharing of your personal information, we will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliates, unless the law allows, and we will limit sharing among our affiliates to the extent required by state law.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.
